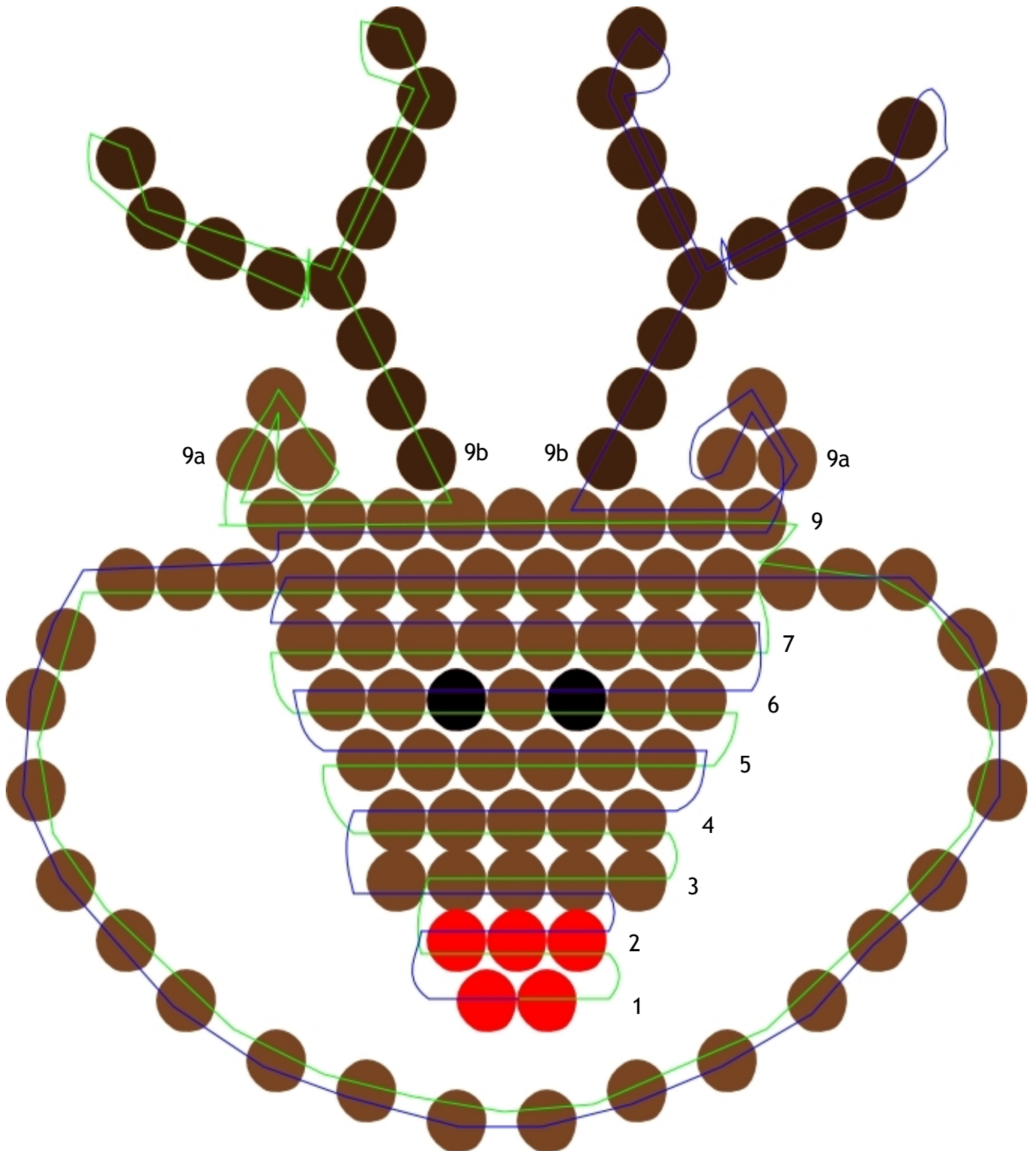


Reindeer Beaded Serviette Holder



You will need 4mm beads with reasonably large holes in the following colours:



2 x black



5 x red



24 x dark brown



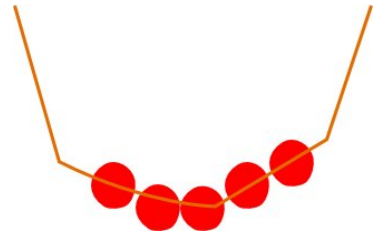
76 x medium brown

You will also need craft wire of gauge 28 (copper coloured is ideal but not essential).

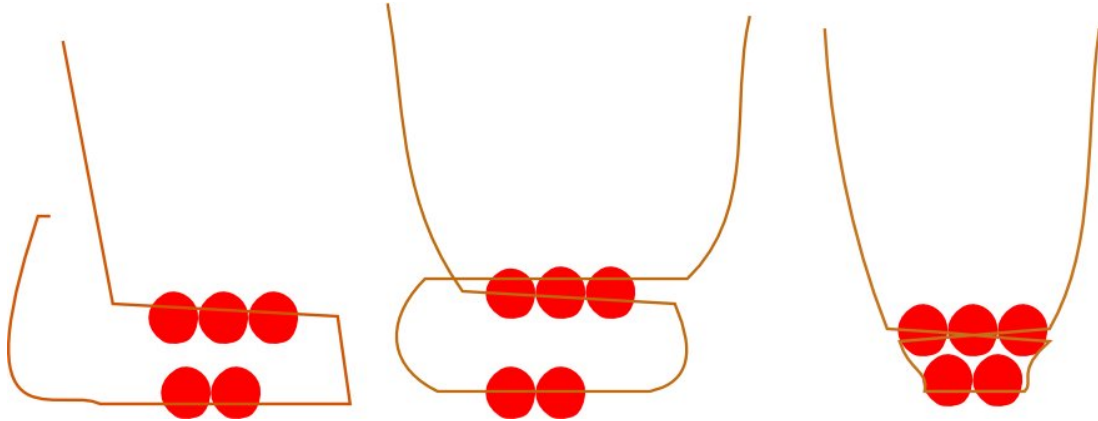


Detailed Instructions

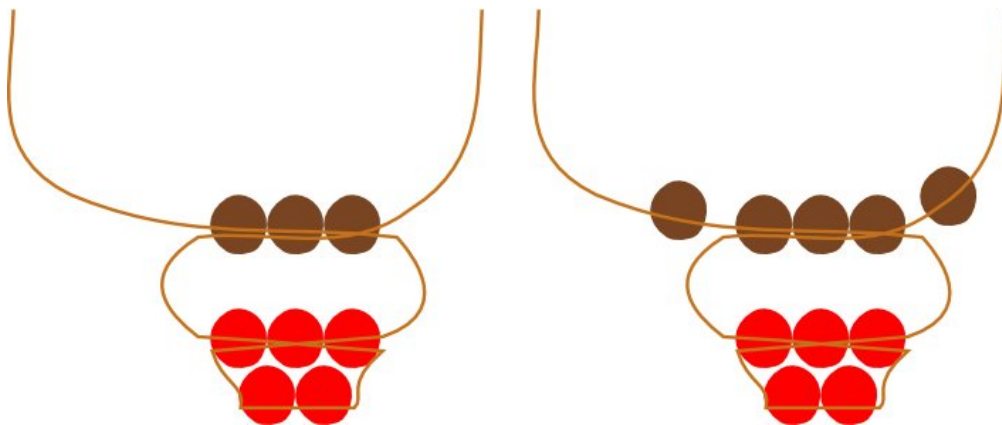
Begin by threading 5 red beads onto your wire.



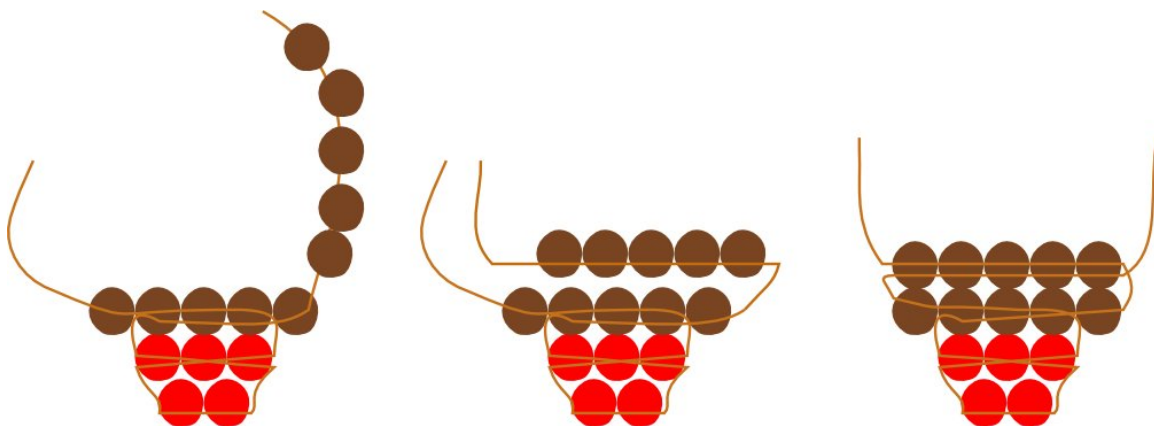
Re-thread one end of your wire through three of the beads and pull tight.



Thread 3 light brown beads as shown below. Then add an extra bead to each piece of wire.

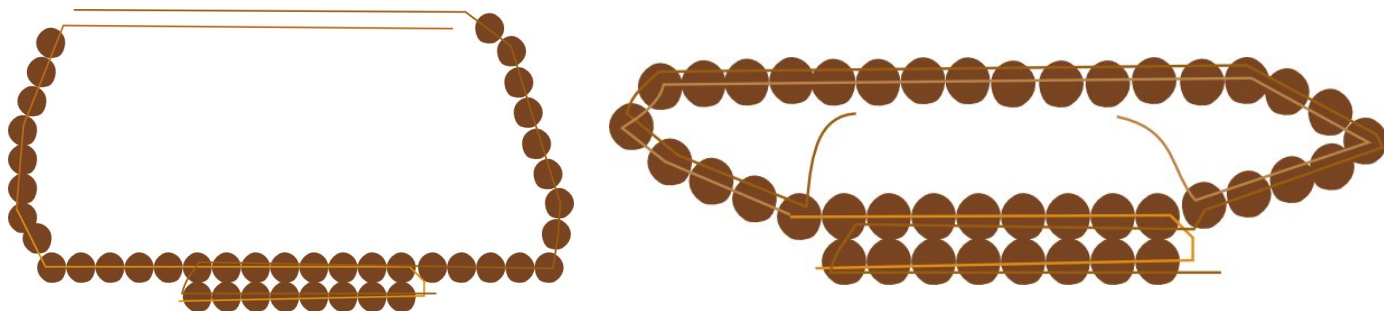


Thread 5 beads onto one piece of wire. Thread the other piece of wire through the 5 beads.



Lines 5, 6, 7 and 8 are threaded in the same way as line 4, simply using a different number of and different colour beads.

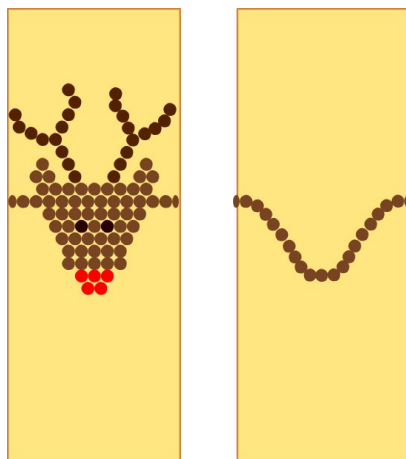
After line 8, thread 12 beads onto each end of wire, then thread each wire through the opposite set of beads. Pull the wire tight to form a circle.



Continue to thread line 9 as normal. The ears and antlers are made from a single wire which is threaded back on itself. They can be bent to form a suitable shape.



When your reindeer is completely threaded wrap the wire round neatly to secure it. Tuck your folded napkin inside the circle then gently pinch the back to hold it in place.
