

Instructions for Making Chocolate Nests

To make 2 large chocolate nests you will need: 150g milk chocolate, 4 shredded wheat (e.g. Weetabix), 10 mini eggs



1) After washing your hands, break 150g chocolate into a suitable bowl and melt it in the microwave (approximately 50 seconds) or over a pan of hot water. (Younger children - make sure an adult helps you with this!)



2) Use your fingers to scrunch up the Weetabix. Pour them into the melted chocolate.

3) Mix the Weetabix in thoroughly until completely covered in chocolate.

4) Use a spoon to put a large dollop (two heaped spoons) onto a piece of silver foil.



5) Use your fingers to push the chocolate mixture together and shape it into a nest (higher at the sides than in the middle).

6) Add five mini eggs to your nest.



7) If using cooking chocolate, leave your nest to set at room temperature. If using ordinary chocolate, place in the fridge until set.
