

Instructions For Pop Up Chick Card



1) Use the oval template to cut two egg shapes from card. You might like to use brightly coloured or holographic card. Alternatively you could cover plain white card with pretty wrapping paper or draw your own patterns onto it.

2) Optional: If you would like your egg to be attached to a card, fold one A4 piece of card in half. Stick one egg to the front of the card.

3) Cut across the other egg where the zig-zag lines are drawn on the template.

4) Carefully glue around the edge of the larger egg piece and stick it to the whole egg. Be careful - do not get any glue in the centre or along the top of the egg.

5) Use the chick template to cut a chick shape from yellow card.

6) Place the chick inside the egg, pushing it down as far as you can.

7) Use a glue stick to put glue on the small amount of the chick's head that is sticking out. Push the smaller egg piece that you have not yet used onto the chick's head, checking it matches up with the bottom half of the egg.

8) Pull the chick out. Cut out the eyes and stick on your chick.

9) Cut out the beak and colour it orange or cut it from orange card. Fold the beak in half (where the grey line is on the template) and stick it on your chick.

10) Write an Easter message on your chick's tummy, inside the card or on the back of the egg.

11) Optional: Add patterns to your egg using glitter glue.
