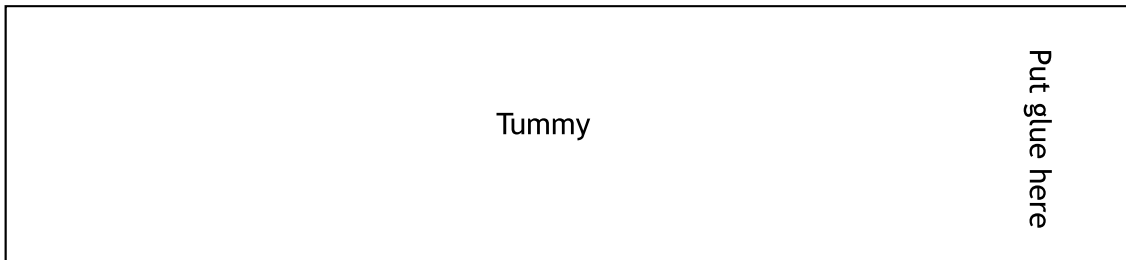
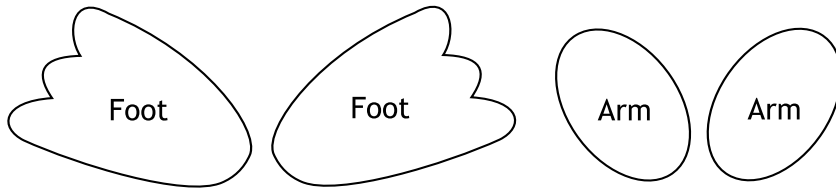
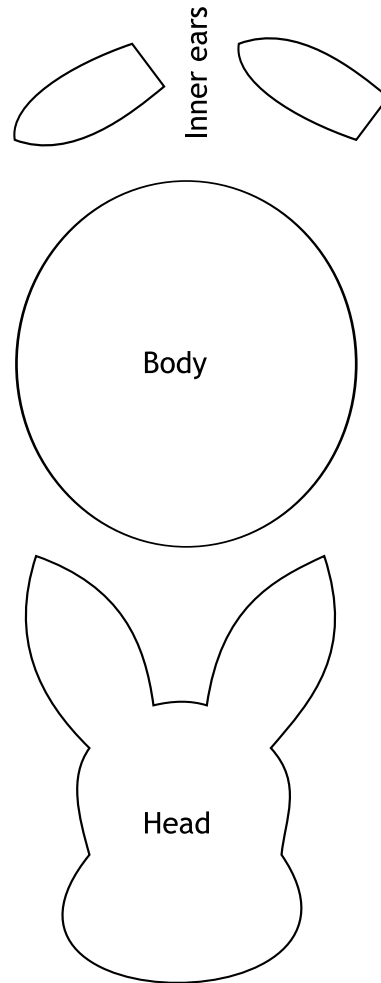


# Template and Instructions for Rabbit Egg holder



1) Use the templates to cut a head, body, tummy, feet and arms from white craft foam.

2) Use the templates to cut inner ears from pink craft foam.

3) Using a suitable glue for craft foam (e.g. tacky pva) stick the tummy into a circle. Check the size by wrapping it around the smaller end of a chocolate egg. Secure with a paper clip until dry.

4) Glue the inner ears onto the ears.

5) Add or draw google eyes, a nose and mouth to your rabbit's face.

6) When the tummy has dried remove the paper clip and glue the body to the back of it.

7) Glue the head to the body, above the tummy.

8) Glue the feet onto the front of the tummy.

9) Glue the arms onto the side of the tummy.

10) Optional: Glue a small pink pom-pom to the back for a tail.
