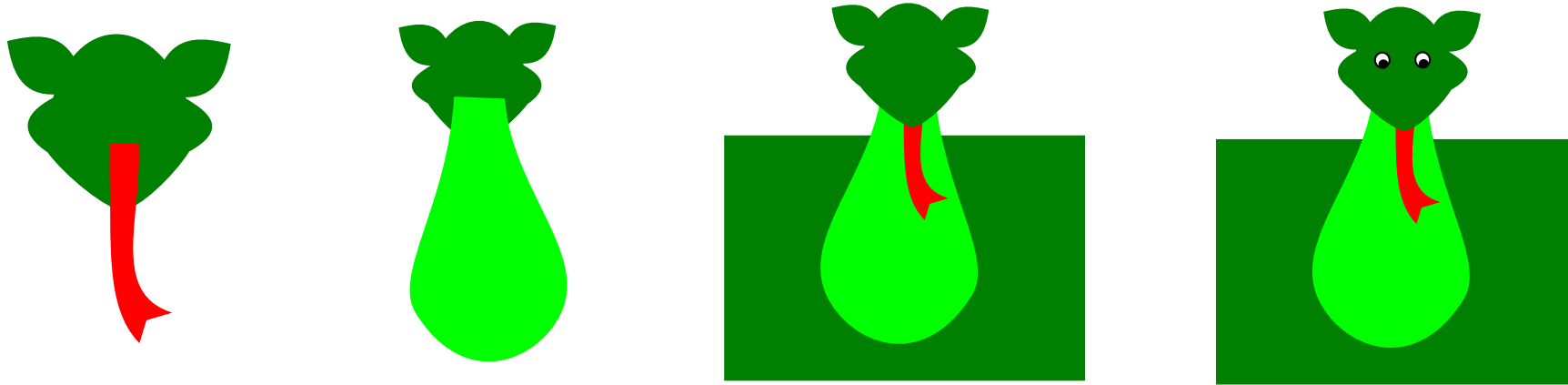


## Instructions for Making a Craft Foam or Paper Dragon

- 1) Cut pieces 1, 2, 3 and 7 from one colour craft foam and piece number 4 from a different colour craft foam.
- 2) Cut piece 6 from red sugar paper. Curl the tongue round a pencil and then pull the pencil carefully (but firmly) along the length of the tongue to curl it.
- 3) Glue piece 6 onto the back of piece 1. Glue piece 1 onto piece 4. Glue piece 4 onto piece 2. Glue eyes onto the face.



- 4) Carefully glue a sheet of tissue paper onto piece 5 and cut it out.

**IMPORTANT!:** Do not continue until piece 4 is completely dry. If it is still wet, it will come unstuck!

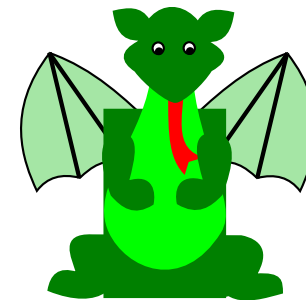
- 5) Glue along one edge of piece 2. Bend it round, sticking one edge to the other to make a tube. Hold in place with a paper clip at each end until dry.

- 6) When dry glue the legs (piece 3) to the back of your dragon so that they stick out to the side and front. (You may need another paper clip to secure them whilst drying.)

- 7) Glue on the wings (piece 5).

- 8) Glue on the arms (piece 7).

- 9) Optional: To hang your dragon, use a needle to thread cotton through the body at the base of the wings.



Alternative: Print, colour, cut and stick to make a paper dragon. Not as sturdy but just as cute.
