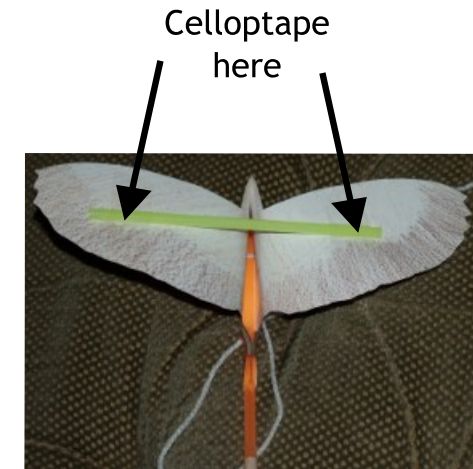
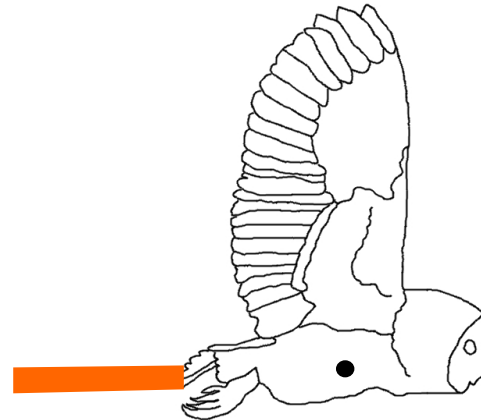
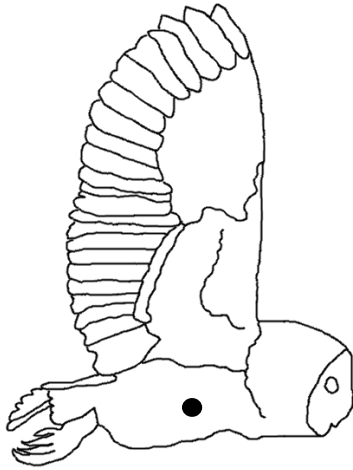


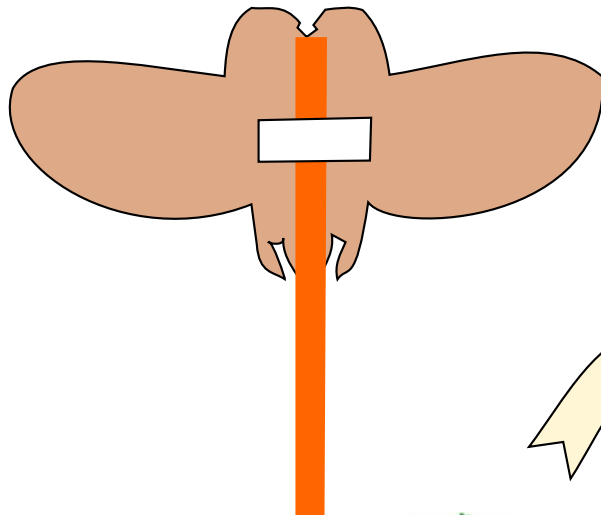
## Instructions for Making an Owl Kite

- 1) Colour your owl and cut it out. Fold it in half along the dotted line to crease. 4) Glue the head and feet together.



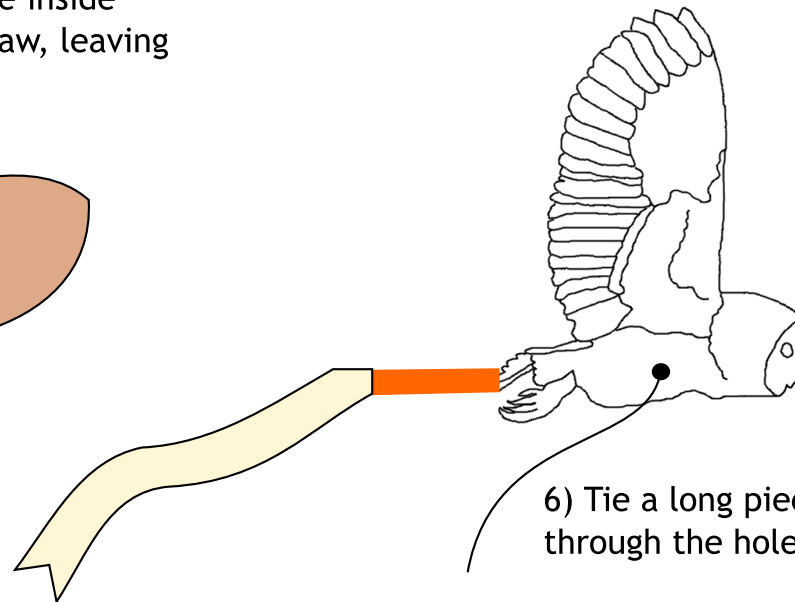
- 2) Use a hole punch to punch holes as shown.

- 3) Cellotape a drinking straw to the inside of your kite. Cut off the excess straw, leaving approximately 5cm at the rear.



- 5) Stick a piece of ribbon approximately 60cm long and 1cm wide to the end of your straw.

- 7) Open out the wings and stick a straw approximately 13cm in length to the top of them



- 6) Tie a long piece of wool through the hole.

To make your kit fly, hold onto the wool and run with the kite travelling behind you.
