

How to Make a Clay Rose



1) Roll 1/4 of your clay into a ball.



2) Flatten and pinch the ball to make a thick rectangle.



3) Pinch to make a long, thin rectangle.



4) Roll the rectangle and squeeze at the bottom.

5) Divide the rest of your clay into as many equal pieces as you would like petals (we recommend 6 or 8).



6) Roll each piece into a ball and then pinch it into the petal shape shown above.



7) Attach the petal to the centre of your rose.



8) Repeat step 7 until a single layer of petals are attached.

9) Attach the next layer of petals to the outside of the first, alternating the spacing.
