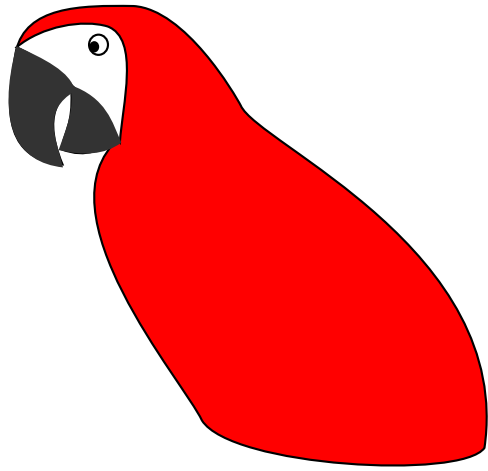


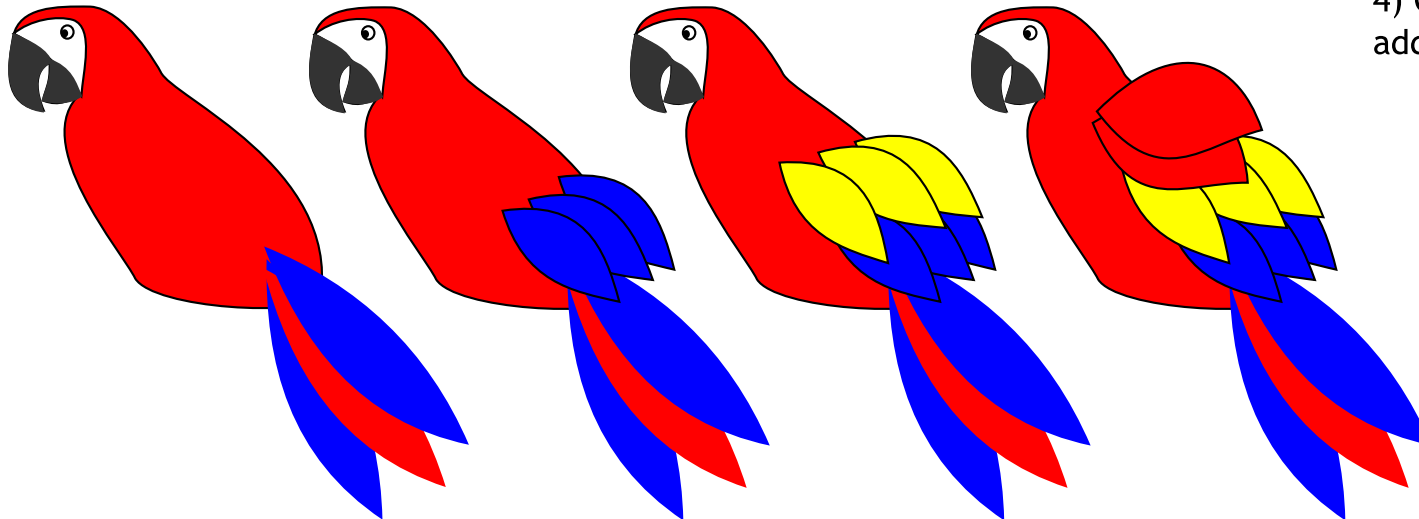
Instructions for making a Leaf Rubbing Parrot



1) Cut the body shape from red or yellow card. Glue on the face.

2) Gather 1 long, fairly thin leaf, one slightly smaller thin leaf and another leaf that is wider. (Freshly fallen leaves work best.) You will also need paper and coloured crayons. Place one leaf under a sheet of paper. Rub with the flat edge of a crayon, then cut out.

3) Repeat step 2 until you have 3 long leaves (we used 2 blue and 1 red), 6 medium long leaves (we used 3 yellow and 3 blue) and two wider leaves (we used red). Glue them to your bird as shown below:



4) Optional: Attach a stick to the back or add cardboard claws.

Try it this way: make your parrot double sided. Stick in the ground and watch the wind blow. Can be used as a weather vane. (Remember to bring your parrot indoors if it rains.)
