

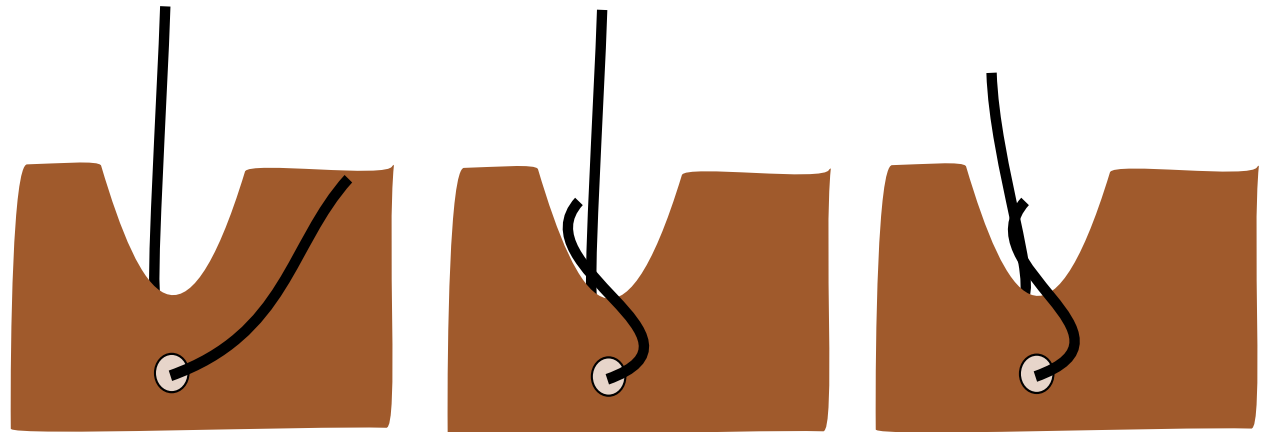
## How to Make a Monkey Note Holder



You can twist your monkey's tail round something to hang it from (e.g. a doorhandle, nail in the wall, curtain rail).

Your monkey can hold greetings cards, postcards, reminder notes - or anything else made of paper or card that you'd like to display!

- 1) Draw round the body template onto brown craft foam and cut your body shape out.
- 2) Draw round the head template onto brown craft foam and cut your head shape out.
- 3) Cut out the monkey face and glue onto the head.
- 4) Stick goggle eyes onto the face.
- 5) Glue the face onto the body.
- 6) Use a holepunch (if you have a large enough one) or carefully make a hole where the tail should go.
- 7) Poke a furry brown or black pipe cleaner through the hole. Twist the end to secure.



- 8) When your monkey has dried, ask an adult to attach a clothespeg to the back of each arm using a glue gun or wood glue.
