

How to Make a Textured Star-fish

- 1) Cut the template from card and fold as described.
- 2) Cover in pva glue.
- 3) Cover with sand. Some thick sections and some thin sections will add to the effect.
- 4) Optional: Repeat step 2 and 3 to create a more highly textured star-fish.
- 4) Leave to dry.
- 5) When completely dry, carefully paint using a soft paint brush or sponge.



Alternative version: For a quicker craft activity, make the star from coloured card. Apply tacky pva glue in a pattern (you will need to use a glue with a nozzle to create fine lines). Sprinkle coloured craft sand over the glue and leave to dry.



Safety Note

Sand used for crafts must be clean. A new packet of children's play sand that has been sieved and washed by the manufacturer would be ideal. Please be aware that sand from the beach may contain rubbish, dog poo, small animals and other substances which could be unsafe.
