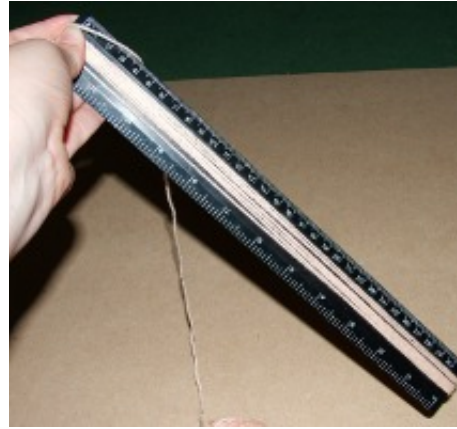
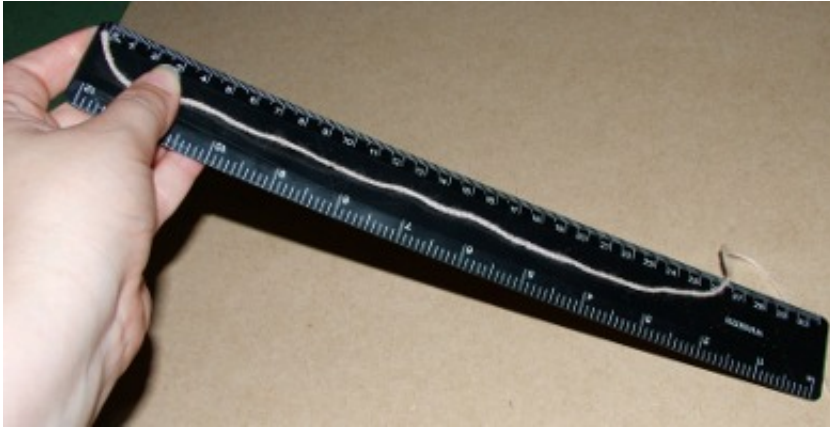


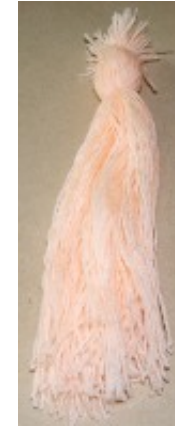
How to Make a Woollen Octopus



1) Wrap wool around a 30cm ruler, back and front nine times.

2) Carefully cut the wool at the top and bottom to create 18 30cm pieces of wool.

3) Repeat another seven times.



4) Gather all the wool together and tie at the top with another piece of wool.

5) Tie a second piece of wool a few centimetres lower than the first to create the head.



6) Plait 18 pieces of wool (6 pieces per section of the plait) to make each leg. Use a small piece of wool to tie the end of each plait.

7) Stick goggle eyes onto your octopus.

Tip: Get a friend to hold your octopus whilst plaiting the legs or hold your octopus with your toes!
