

Instructions for making a Robin Finger Puppet

Cut out the pieces using the template at <http://ideas4kids.org/139>



Carefully glue where shown using a glue suitable for sticking felt. With most glues you should wait 30 seconds or so for the glue to dry slightly before pushing the pieces together. Put your finger gently in the centre as shown then move to one side to dry. Alternatively, place the wings as shown. Put the second body piece on top and sew the pieces together. Turn inside out.

Glue on the wings (unless sewn in place). Next glue the cream belly in place as shown. Then glue the red piece on top. Glue on the beak. Add felt circles or goggle eyes.

Ensure your puppet is completely dry before playing with it.

Please note that small parts make this craft unsuitable for children under the age of 3.
