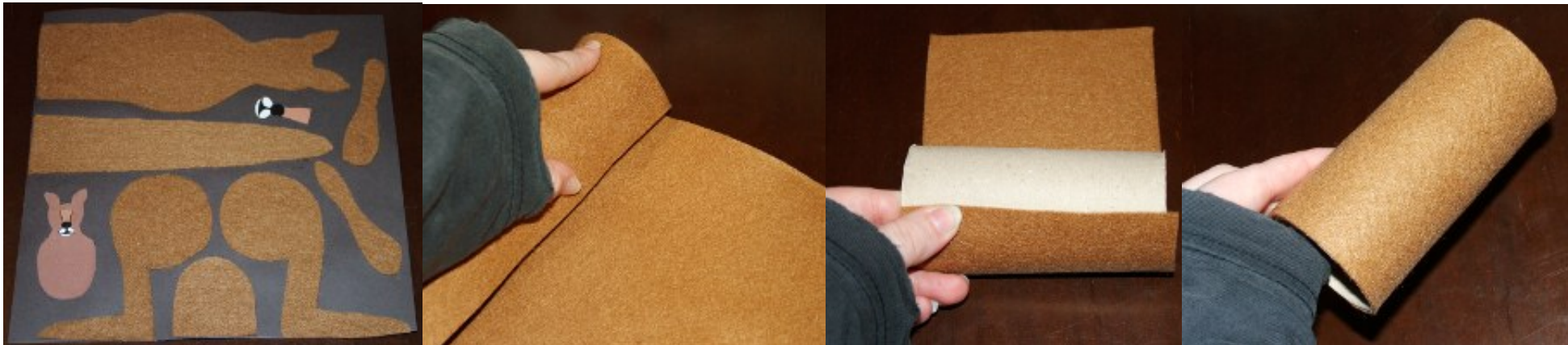


Kanagroo Instructions

You will need: A clean toilet roll inner, a piece of brown felt, a brown piece of card (almost A4 sized), glue suitable for sticking felt, a printed copy of the Kangaroo template.

- 1) Using the template, cut the body, legs, arms and pouch from reddish-brown felt.
- 2) Glue the felt and the nose and Joey (baby Kangaroo) to a piece of brown card and leave to dry.
- 3) Wrap a piece of brown felt round the toilet roll inner. Cut a rectangular piece large enough to cover the roll and then glue it in place. Leave to dry.



- 4) Stick your pieces together, starting with the main body of the Kangaroo. You do not need to glue the main body to the loo roll. Just slide it down the inside of the tube until it looks right (this will depend on the size of the tube you used). Make sure you only stick the edges of the pouch, so the Joey can slot inside. Glue to tail to the inside of the tube and bend it upwards.
- 5) Add goggle eyes to the Kangaroo mother and Joey.

You can use your Kangaroo as a decorative piece of art or glue it to a piece of cardboard and use it as a pencil holder.

Try it this way: For a cheaper craft, use brown card without felt. For an even cheaper craft, print the template on thick paper, colour in and assemble.
