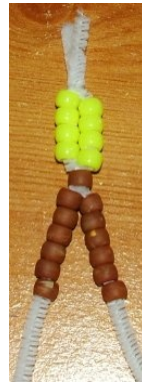
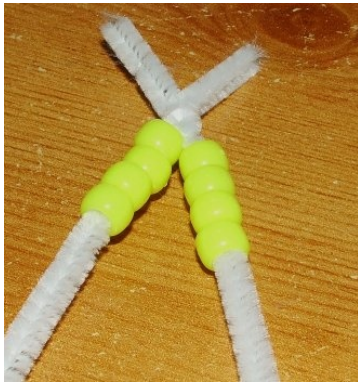


Making a Guiding (UK) Doll from Pipe Cleaners



1) Twist 2 pipe cleaners together, leaving about 4cm at the top. Thread 4 pony beads into each pipe cleaner. (Light blue for rainbows, yellow for brownies and dark blue for guides.)

2) Tightly twist the 2 pipe cleaners together, below the beads. Thread 1 bead over both pipe cleaners and then 6 beads onto each pipe cleaner. (Red for rainbows, brown for brownies and a trouser colour for guides.) Twist each pipe cleaner round to make the feet (make sure the beads won't fall off).



3) Cut off the extra white pipe cleaner. Twist 1 of the extra pipe cleaner round the 'neck' of your doll. For guides thread 6 dark blue beads on each arm. For the long sleeved brownie uniform, thread alternating light blue and white beads as shown. For the brownie short sleeved uniform, thread 3 brown beads. For the rainbow doll thread 3 red beads. Twist the pipe cleaner to make the hands. With the short sleeved uniforms, there will be a longer piece making the lower arm too. Make sure the beads can not come off.



4) At the top, slide one bead over the top of both pipe cleaners (dark blue for guides, red for Rainbows, yellow for the long sleeved brownie uniform and brown for the short sleeved Brownie uniform).

5) Push a cotton or polystyrene ball onto the pipe cleaners. Add facial features.

6) Cut lengths of wool for the hair. Use PVA (or a glue gun with adult help) to attach the hair.
